1 THE HISTORY OF WELLSPRING

Wellspring Church was founded in 2023 by a group of Methodists committed to the inspiration and authority of Scripture, and burdened with a passion to proclaim the “faith once delivered to all the saints” (Jude 3).

The first meeting was held on September 17th at Holy Trinity Anglican Church in Madison, MS. The church first met every Sunday in the evenings and preachers were supplied by various individuals from the community who were known for their commitment to biblical authority and Methodist doctrine.

In January 2024, Dr. Matt Ayars was named the first full-time pastor of Wellspring Church.

The congregation continued to meet on Sunday evenings at Holy Trinity Anglican Church until the late Fall 2024 when they moved into their new church building at 418 Business Park Drive. Just prior to moving into the new building, the church voted by an overwhelming majority to join the Global Methodist Church.

2 WHAT IS METHODISM?

Wellspring Church is a Global Methodist Church. Methodism traces its origins to 18th-century England with the evangelical movement led by John Wesley, his brother Charles Wesley, and George Whitefield. The movement sought to reform the Church of England (the Anglican Church) and revitalize Christianity in England through a methodical approach to faith and practice, hence the name “Methodism” (which was originally a derogatory title given to the original participants).

What became a world-wide movement began with the Wesley brothers’ zeal and hunger for a powerful, devout, and pietistic Christianity that moved beyond the cultural Christianity which marked much of Anglicanism in England at the time. The Wesley’s believed in the promises of scripture for believers who were supernaturally empowered by the Holy Spirit—on the basis of Christ’s atoning work—to live free not only from the guilt of sin but also the power of sinning. They believed that 2 Timothy 3:5 perfectly described Anglican Christianity as a “form of religion but denying the power” (2 Tim. 3:5) and were moved by the hunger for righteousness to preach the good news of a life that conformed to the risen-ness of Christ rather than the fallen-ness of Adam.

The Global Methodist Church

The Global Methodist Church (GMC) is a vibrant, connectional Christian denomination rooted in the historic Wesleyan tradition. Formed in 2022, it upholds the authority of Scripture and emphasizes the core values of holiness, grace, and missional living. The GMC is committed to making disciples of Jesus Christ who worship passionately, love extravagantly, and witness boldly. With a strong focus on global outreach, church planting, and theological clarity, it provides a welcoming home for believers seeking a biblically grounded, Christ-centered, and Spirit-led faith community. The denomination embraces accountability, connectional relationships, and a shared mission to spread the love and truth of Christ throughout the world.

3 OUR CORE BELIEFS

Methodists, as part of the broader Wesleyan tradition, hold to several core beliefs that shape our theology and practice. While there are variations among different Methodist denominations, the foundational beliefs include the following:

1. **The Authority of Scripture.** Methodists affirm that the Bible is the inspired Word of God and the primary authority for faith and practice. While we respect tradition, reason, and experience as sources of theological reflection, Scripture remains the ultimate guide.
2. **The Trinity.** Like all orthodox Christians, Methodists believe in one God in three persons:
 - **God the Father.** The Creator and Sustainer of all things.
 - **God the Son (Jesus Christ).** Fully divine and fully human, who provides salvation through His death and resurrection.
 - **God the Holy Spirit.** The presence of God active in the world, working in believers for sanctification and spiritual growth.
3. **Salvation by Grace through Faith.** Methodists strongly emphasize grace, particularly through John Wesley's framework of:
 - **Prevenient Grace.** God's grace that draws all people to Himself, enabling them to respond to His call.
 - **Justifying Grace.** The grace by which a person is forgiven of sin and made right with God through faith in Jesus Christ.
 - **Sanctifying Grace.** The grace that works in believers to make us more holy and Christlike throughout our lives.
4. **The Necessity of Personal and Social Holiness.** John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, taught that faith must be lived out through holy living. Methodists emphasize both personal piety (prayer, Scripture reading, worship) and social holiness (caring for the poor, advocating for justice, and working toward societal transformation).
5. **The Role of Good Works.** Methodists believe that while salvation is by grace through faith alone, good works naturally flow from a true faith. This belief aligns

with James 2:17: “Faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.” Acts of charity, service, and justice are viewed as a response to God’s grace, not a means of earning salvation.

6. **The Sacraments: Baptism and the Lord’s Supper.** Methodists practice infant and believer’s baptism, viewing it as an outward sign of God’s grace and a means of entering the Christian community. When it comes to the Eucharist, Methodists believe in an open table, meaning all believers (regardless of denomination) are welcome to partake in communion as a means of grace.
7. **Free Will and Rejecting Predestination.** Unlike Calvinism, Methodists reject unconditional election and predestination. We affirm that God’s grace is available to all people (John 3:16 and 1 Tim. 2:4–7), and individuals have free will to accept or reject salvation.
8. **The Church and Christian Community.** Methodists believe the Church is the Body of Christ, called to worship, disciple believers, and engage in mission. We practice connectionalism, meaning churches are linked through a larger governing body (e.g., the United Methodist Church, the Global Methodist Church).
9. **The Call to Evangelism and Mission.** Evangelism and social justice are central to Methodism. Methodists engage in global missions, education, healthcare, and social reform as ways to demonstrate God’s love.
10. **The Second Coming of Christ.** Methodists affirm that Christ will return, though we do not emphasize specific end-times prophecies. Our focus is on faithful living in the present rather than speculation about the future.

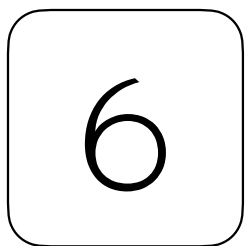

WHAT IS CHURCH MEMBERSHIP?

Being a Christian means being *in Christ* (1 Cor. 5:17; Rom. 8:1; Gal. 2:20; Jn. 15:4–5). One cannot be in Christ without being part of the body of Christ, which is the church. The redemptive work of Jesus not only reconciles individuals to Jesus, but to the world.

To be baptized is not only to be cleansed from sin, but to be born into the family of God. To be a Christian is to be a member of a family and a citizen of a Kingdom. Jesus plainly teaches that being an active member of the covenant people of God is necessary to being a Christian. Becoming a member of a local church body, then, validates one's identity with Christ as one of his followers.

Spiritual Growth and Accountability

Membership offers an environment for spiritual growth through regular worship, prayer, and study. At Wellspring we encourage members to uphold and support each other spiritually, holding each other accountable in faith and conduct.

Community and Belonging

A church provides a community where members can find fellowship and form relationships with others who share their beliefs. Membership often strengthens this sense of belonging and mutual support, fostering a deeper connection with others.

Commitment to Service and Mission

Being a member means committing to serve alongside others within the church. Members are often encouraged to take active roles in ministries, outreach programs, and charitable work, contributing to a shared mission of impacting the community.

Leadership and Responsibility

Being a part of the Body of Christ means being subject to church leadership and accountability (Heb. 13:17; 1 Pet. 5:2–3; Rom. 13:1; Eph. 5:21; 1 Thess. 5:12–13; Tit. 3:1; 1 Tim. 5:17; Acts 20:28; Matt. 18:17). Joining a church ensures obedience to right Christian practice in this sense. It is also under this leadership that members can exercise their spiritual gifts and build up the church by playing various roles such as teaching, leading small groups, or serving on committees.

Support in Times of Need

In challenging times, members rely on their church community for emotional, spiritual, and sometimes financial support. Churches often prioritize care for their

members, making it a source of comfort and support during crises or personal struggles.

Witness and Testimony

Membership can be a public testament to one's faith and commitment. By joining, individuals demonstrate their alignment with the teachings and mission of that church, serving as an example to others in the community.

In sum, church membership is more than just attending services; it's about actively participating in the life of the church, contributing to a shared purpose, and being part of a supportive community where members journey together in faith.

BECOMING A MEMBER

2. **Affirm Your Faith in Jesus Christ.** Membership at Wellspring Church is for those who have made a personal commitment to follow Jesus Christ. If you have not yet been baptized as a believer, we encourage you to take this important step of faith as part of your membership journey.
3. **Commit to the Church Covenant.** As a member, you will be asked to affirm our church covenant, which includes:
 - A commitment to biblical teaching and discipleship.
 - Active participation in worship, prayer, and fellowship.
 - A heart to serve others and support the mission of the church.
 - A willingness to live in unity and accountability with fellow believers.
4. **Meet with the Pastor or Elder.** After completing the membership class, you will have a personal meeting with the pastor. This is an opportunity to:
 - Share your faith journey.
 - Ask any questions you may have about membership.
 - Discuss how you can get involved in church life.
5. **Be Welcomed into Membership.** Once you have completed these steps, we will formally welcome you into the church family during a Sunday service. This is a time for the congregation to celebrate and pray over new members as they commit to life in the Wellspring Church community.
